Want to see if you have ever created a log in for [www.realtor.org](http://www.realtor.org)?

A log in consists of a User Name and Password, which you should keep in a secure location for future reference.

1. Look up your User Name using your National REALTOR® Database Membership Number (NRDS). Please type <https://reg.realtor.org/roreg.nsf/ForgotUsername?OpenForm> in your web browser.  
Hint: it's NOT your MLS ID.  
Your NRDS number can be found on your membership card from the National Association of REALTORS®, on the label of your REALTOR® magazine or you look it up by typing <https://reg.realtor.org/roreg.nsf/retrieveID?OpenForm> in your web browser.
2. Now that you have your NRDS number, and have used it to look up your User Name, the next step is to look up your password at <https://reg.realtor.org/roreg.nsf/ForgotPassword?OpenForm>

\* **Hint:** If you get a message that *no User Name exists* in the system for you on step # 1 above, you will have to create a registration at

<https://reg.realtor.org/roreg.nsf/ForgotPassword?OpenForm>.
