

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ATTENDEES OF GPBOR EVENTS

July 2021

This Code of Conduct outlines our expectations for participant behavior, as well as the consequences for unacceptable behavior.

- Antitrust Avoidance: State and Federal laws prohibit the exchange of information among competitors
 regarding matters pertaining to price, refusals to deal, market division, tying relationships and other
 topics which might infringe upon antitrust regulations, and that no such exchange or discussion will be
 tolerated during this meeting. These guidelines apply not only to formal meeting sessions, but also to
 informal discussions during breaks, meals, and social gatherings.
- COVID: Registrants agree to adhere to our safety protocols relative to COVID, which shall be distributed
 at time of registration, along with any other safety protocols of the venue and CDC and State of RI
 guidelines.
- Safety & Inclusivity: The Greater Providence Board of REALTORS® (GPBOR) is committed to creating a safe and inclusive experience for all. We do not tolerate inappropriate behavior or harassment in any form. Inappropriate behavior includes harassing or defamatory verbal or written comments, displays of illicit images or use of illicit language, threats, intimidation and unwanted physical contact, destruction or vandalizing of personal property or event site or materials or disturbing the peace. Please act professionally and follow our code of conduct at all times. Attendees, presenters, vendors and guests who do not comply with this code of conduct at any event may be removed from said event and prohibited from attending future events.
- If you are subjected to unacceptable behavior, notice that someone else is being subjected to unacceptable behavior, or have any other concerns, please notify our staff as soon as possible.
- **Cellphones:** please silence all cell phones or any other electronic devices.
- Smoking, Illegal Substances & Weapons: smoking is not permitted except in the designated areas.
 Possessing any illegal substances, weapon or any item that can be used as a weapon, which may be used to threaten or cause injury to others if used in a certain manner, will not be tolerated.
